We have the pleasure to inform you that [ITS Hellas](#), the “Hellenic Association for the deployment of Intelligent Transport Systems” organises its **6th Two-Day Conference on "Intelligent Transport Systems and Developments in Greece"**, which will take place virtually on **Monday 14 and Tuesday 15 December 2020**.

Following five successful events, the Digital Conference on "Intelligent Transport Systems and Developments in Greece" will be held with the support of the **European Commission Representation in Greece** and under the auspices of the **Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport**, the **Ministry of Digital Governance**, the **General Secretariat for Research and Technology**, the **Hellenic Institute of Transportation Engineers**, the **Hellenic Confederation of Commerce and Entrepreneurship**, the **Hellenic Association of Mobile Applications Companies**, the **Hellenic Institute for Logistics Management**, the **Hellenic Logistics Association**, the **Greek Cold Storage and Logistics Association**, and the **Hellenic Federation of Road Transports**. This year the Conference focuses on issues related to the European goals and national aspirations and efforts for the transition to a sustainable and "green" mobility.



The main goal of the ITS Hellas Digital Conference is to highlight the importance of the widespread adoption of technologies and applications of smart mobility for the Greek transport system. This goal is becoming more crucial than ever before, as Intelligent Transport Systems technologies and applications are the driving force behind the **European Green Deal's objectives** for sustainable European mobility. The discussion will focus on the needs and benefits for the transport sector in Greece, and also on the opportunities for a general reconstruction of the economy through the "green" transition to the digital age.

This year's digital event will host six sessions and interactive discussions which will be thoroughly examined by experts and professionals in the field, representatives of the authorities and the academic and research community, from Greece and abroad. The sessions will be focused on the following topics:

- European and National Policies and Strategy for a Green and Sustainable Mobility
- Smart Mobility and European developments
- Smart Cities and Sustainable Urban Mobility: a holistic approach
- Electromobility in Greece: Current situation and next steps
- Green ports and freight transport
- Data collection and management

In the framework of the conference, two additional Workshops will be held and will be focused on the activities and research work conducted within the [C-ROADS Greece](#) and the [2CeVau](#) European projects. The scope of the C-ROADS Greece Workshop, which will be held on Monday the 14th of December, is to inform national stakeholders (passenger and freight transport) and key players for the deployment of Cooperative Intelligent Transport Systems (C-ITS) in Greece with special focus on the test sites (Egnatia Pilot and Attica Pilot) and also consult them to latest C-ITS services. Within the frame of the workshop a round table discussion will be hosted on the presented topics aiming to share experiences and receive valuable feedback from the participants.

The objective of the 2CeVau workshop, which will be held on Tuesday the 15th of December, is two-fold: on the one hand it seeks to inform the participants on the relevant cyber-security challenges in (automated driving) corridors and discuss the so-far 2CeVau technical results. On the other hand, the workshop will promote the exchange of ideas, proposals and fruitful discussions among the research community and the intelligent transport systems industrial experts.



The 6th ITS Hellas Digital Conference will be a first class opportunity for constructive dialogue, exchange of views, good practices and experiences, as well as for the promotion of synergies.
